

# Rooster Instructions

## Materials Needed:

Plastic Canvas

Yarn

Needle - recommend using a

#16 yarn tapestry (blunt) needle

## Yarn Colors Needed:

Red

Orange

Yellow

Green

Blue

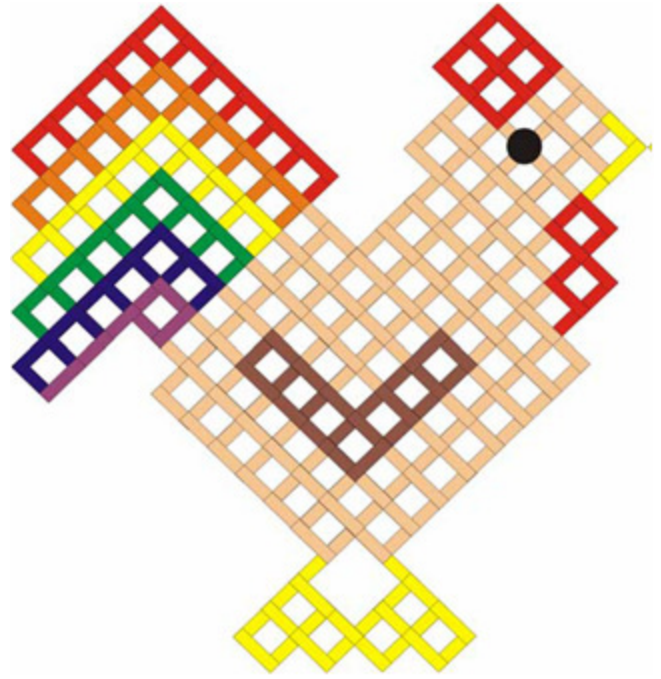
Purple

Dark Brown (for Wing)

Tan

Black (for Eye)

**Optional:** Rainbow-colored yarn for Necklace



**Stitching Sequence:** (you may want to use your own sequence; this is just a suggestion)

It is suggested that a diagonal stitch be used.

It requires more yarn and leaves a longer stitch on the back, but it also gives better coverage on the front and doesn't leave 'holes'.

If you want to use a different stitch, that's fine as long as the coverage is there.

1. Start with Orange.

(You may want to do the same color on several roosters, then go on to the next color.)

2. Then proceed to Yellow (in tail), Green, Blue, and Purple; then the Tan.

3. Stitch the Dark Brown "Wing" stitches over the Tan stitches.

4. Stitch a French Knot for the eye (or do an 'X' if you don't do French Knots).

5. Stitch all the Red.

6. Stitch the Yellow beak and feet.

With the feet the goal is coverage. There are no incorrect stitches.

Terminate all threads by running them under the same color.

**Do not** end Red thread under Yellow stitches or it will show through on the front.

Exact color matches are not necessary.

Make Necklace by using a piece of thread and making it at least **24 inches long**.

You can use any color or even a piece of rainbow-colored yarn if you have it.

Connect the necklace through the square between the tail and head.

**60 Roosters are needed to supply each walk; however, some are then not used by the Walk (are returned to Agape), so check with the Agape Chairperson about how many are needed.**
