Front Side:

“Christ is counting on you” – as much today, tomorrow, and every day as the day you got your cross.

Reverse Side:

Chi-Rho: The first two letters of the Greek word for Christ (Christos (Xpistos)), the Chi-Rho (XP) was widely used by the early church as a monogram of Christ.

This is the emblem that Constantine saw in the sky with the cross and the words, “in this sign, conquer.” The battle was fought to save Rome in 312 AD, and he was victorious. He had this design put on his banners and proclaimed Christianity to be the official religion of the entire Roman Empire. As a result, the Chi-Rho is one of Christianity’s most ancient symbols.
